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Social and Emotional Learning (**SEL**), is a process through which students develop and apply the knowledge, attitudes, and **skills necessary to understand and navigate their emotions, set and achieve positive goals**, understand and show **empathy** for others, establish and maintain positive respectful **relationships**, and make **responsible decisions**.

At the **centre of SEL** there are **5 core competencies**: Self-Awareness, Self-Management, Social Awareness, Relationship Skills and Responsible Decision Making which are broad interrelated areas that support learning and development.

Participants will learn **strategies** on how to empower their students to learn to **manage emotions** and **deal with stress/anxiety** while at the same time as improving their academic performance. Educators will learn how to model and integrate SEL practices into their classrooms, develop school and community partnerships and make meaningful connections.

This workshop is designed to give participants the knowledge and skills to be able to **integrate SEL throughout the school's academic curricula** and culture, across schoolwide practices and policies, and through ongoing collaboration with families and the wider educational community in order to ensure that every student has the space, the skills and the support they need, to learn, grow and thrive. SEL can be a powerful lever to help make this happen.

BENEFITS OF SEL IN EDUCATION:

Integrating social and emotional learning in education provides for a more **holistic approach** to learning and development. It gives our students the space to explore who they are as people, to look at their identity and that of those around them and to celebrate one another's differences, fostering cultural awareness, mutual understanding and social cohesion.

The course will cover the following aspects:



SEL Principles and Background

We will explore the core competencies of SEL and how these interrelated areas support learning and development and we will look at how as educators we can help students develop the more holistic skills they need for life.

Strategies and Techniques in SEL

Participants will be equipped with strategies on how to empower their students to learn to manage emotions and deal with stress/anxiety while at the same as improving their academic performance

Strengthen Relationships

We will explore how SEL can bring families, schools and communities together to make sure every child has caring relationships and what they need to learn, grow and thrive in a more harmonious learning environment.

Conflict Resolution and Communication

We will learn how to give students the skills to master effective communication and engage in effective conflict resolution fostering a positive classroom environment

Understanding Stress

Combining an understanding and knowledge of stress management with the skills to develop and enhance processes for integrating emotional intelligence into everyday situations and settings while fostering the ability to make responsible decisions.

Self-Care and Self-Management

Participants will learn how to cultivate greater self-awareness and self-esteem in themselves and their students while at the same time as learning self-management skills.

Inclusion and Connection in the classroom

We will learn about how inclusion and stronger connections can be achieved between peers and between teachers and students through building trust and understanding and empathy.

Empowering Students

Offer practical examples on how to give students the space to explore who they are as people and to equip them with skills to create that space for others too.

How you will expand your knowledge:



As educators this workshop will provide you with an in-depth knowledge of the SEL framework and its applications in an educational setting. An understanding of how to adapt and model this framework while being mindful of the diversity of learners in order to establish equitable and inclusive learning environments.

As well as learning about SEL participants will have the opportunity to refresh their English language ability. By connecting with fellow educators from all over Europe, participants will benefit from sharing experiences and expertise.

The strategies and insights gained here will inspire you to continue growing as educators and create enriching learning experiences for your students and the mobility offers valuable networking opportunities for future collaboration.
